

Stanislaw (Stan) Golec, MD MPH

Physician, psychiatric clinician and behavioral health manager with experience in:

Education: Dr. Golec received his Medical Doctor degree from Lublin Medical University in Poland. He completed postgraduate training at Lafayette Clinic - DMC/WSU Psychiatric Residency training program in Detroit, MI in 1988. While working full time at the trauma level I Detroit Receiving Hospital he obtained MPH degree in Health Management and Policy from University of Michigan School of Public Health in 1998. He also completed 3-year CSAP sponsored Faculty Development Program in Substance Abuse at Wayne State University Addiction Research Institute (1995-1998). Subsequently, he also completed advanced fellowship (post-doctoral training) at the New York State Psychiatric Institute affiliated with New York's Columbia University in 2006-2007.

Work Experience: First post-residency job at Detroit Receiving Hospital with subsequent transition to Detroit Medical Center and affiliation with Wayne State University School of Medicine. Later he transitioned to University of Michigan and with managerial MPH he held Medical Director job at healthcare insurance organizations in Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania and Florida subsequently returning to clinical care in Michigan VA hospitals in Ann Arbor, Battle Creek and currently working at the Detroit VA Medical Center.

Military Service: Dr. Golec commissioned to the USAR Medical Corps as a Major in 2011. His first assignment was 322nd MC in Southfield. After his AMEDD BOLC training he deployed to Camp Buehring in Kuwait. Later he completed Captains Career Course in 2014 and the General Command and Staff College. Promoted to LTC in 2016 and reassigned to the 246 Combat Support Hospital in Blacklick, OH; he advanced his military educations with COSC and TEM courses. He deployed with the 801-3 UAMTF to New York City with FEMA-led US Army COVID-19 response on the East Coast (April-June 2020). Initial assignment to the 2500-bed field hospital at the Javits Convention was changed to the first line response at the Bronx Lincoln Hospital and Psychiatric Center. Promoted to Colonel in July 2020, he received CENTCOM deployment orders with the 3D MCDS (FWD) in August 2020 and mobilized to Camp Arifjan in Kuwait. In 2021 he deployed again, assigned to US Army Hospital in Landstuhl, Germany.

OLS Schools: Dr. Golec has been supporting SSCM Seminarians and the Orchard Lake Schools for more than three decades. His younger son graduated from St Mary's Preparatory School in 2012. In 2018 Dr. Golec became Ambassador of the Orchard Lake Schools.
